This event is taking place to share the work of contemporary artists and composers and features a selection of pre-recorded performances.


Before the event:

What to expect during the event:




Christopher Kirubi reads a selection of poetry, which we hear over a film. (8 mins) This section is pre-recorded. A transcript is available.
