THE WHITECHAPEL ART GALLERY

OPEN EXHIBITION

Each year the Whitechapel Art Gallery includes as a fundamental and traditional part of its programme, an exhibition of work by artists and craftsmen living or working in East London. Recently the number of artists submitting work for the exhibition has increased dramatically. In 1977, for instance, 376 artists submitted, 548 in 1978 and, in spite of a reduction in the geographical area covered by the exhibitors, over 800 for this year. While this has meant selecting less than one in ten of the works submitted, and unfortunately having to disappoint a large number of artists, the increasing importance of the visual arts in the East End, on both the amateur and professional levels, is apparent.

The staff of the Gallery involved in the selection this year — Nicholas Serota, Martin Rewcastle and Mark Francis — were joined by Vivien Lovell, the Assistant Arts Officer of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, and we are extremely grateful to her for the care and time which she devoted to this task. Works were selected for inclusion in the exhibition not by majority vote of this committee, but on the strong preference of any one member. The result will inevitably be a show of strong contrasts, but with a committee of four people we felt that one strong response was a more valid test that four lukewarm votes.

In the past two years the Gallery, with the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, has arranged a number of exhibitions of work by local artists in its own foyer and in a variety of locations including schools, offices, public buildings and shops. It has also sponsored two artist in residence schemes at schools on the Isle of Dogs and in Poplar. Several requests for these exhibitions and events came as a result of people seeing work in the Whitechapel Open exhibition. Many of the artists included would be happy to receive visitors in their studios or homes, and a list of their addresses is held in the Gallery office. Please contact Patricia Sweeney to arrange a visit. Most of the works are for sale. The prices are marked in this catalogue, and all enquiries should be directed to the Gallery staff at the front desk.
