

THE WHITECHAPEL OPEN EXHIBITION 1985

For me, the most lasting impression of the selection of works for the 1985 Whitechapel 'Open' will be one of total professional commitment from all those involved and their genuine belief in the concept.

The sheer volume of works submitted was astonishing and the scale of the task of selection and hanging daunting, if not quite impossible. Within the strict limitations of available space only a very small proportion of the total submission could be displayed and even with exacting (even heartless) discrimination, a good exhibition four times the size would have been possible. The selectors are unanimous in their wish to convey their feeling for all those disappointed entrants whose work deserved recognition but could not be hung.

In selecting works which represented the variety submitted we were particularly anxious to exhibit the extraordinary vitality and quality of art produced within the designated catchment area, of which perhaps the most notable is that of the large number of women artists submitting.

The dominance of the professionals may be unsurprising in view of the number working in the East End but the part-time painters were indeed competitive with their contributions.

The most important message, however, is surely to do with the need for many more opportunities for London's artists to exhibit, and thereby contribute to the community in which they live and work. One 'open' exhibition each year is woefully inadequate.
